It is time to begin thinking about the Trip Baronial A&S Competition! Not yet scheduled, it will be sometime in early spring.


For the Unser Hafen A&S Champion the requirement will be to submit entries in two categories (they can be in the same category) and one of the pieces can be a work in progress.

Getting to Know Our Populace

Lord Martín De Cuniga and Baroness Arianwyn Sweet



Lord Martín De Cuniga or Jesse Schlam grew up in Aurora, Colorado, where he lived for 18 years. He then went to college in Durago for 4 years and received a BA in sociology, a BA in modern languages focusing on Spanish, and a minor in sociocultural anthropology. He did a study abroad in Vitoria, Spain for a year, and moved to Fort Collins to attend CSU for 3 years, studying environmental engineering and has been there ever since. Jesse works for the city of Fort Collins as an environmental regulatory specialist, keeping the pollution out of the water ways.

Baroness Arianwyn Sweet, also known as The Grey, or mundanely as Carissa "Kisa" Sortman lived most of her life in Arizona. As an air force brat, she was born in West Germany, though only spent a few months there before moving to the States. She spent 22 years in Phoenix, 3 years in Tucson getting her Associates of Art, a year in Tempe at ASU studying Fiber Arts and Metal working, 6 months in Flagstaff, and 3 years in Prescott where she helped open her sister's brew pub, and got her cosmetology licence. She moved to Fort Collins about a year and a half ago, and is cultivating a lovely cosmetology business.

The two met at Estrella War in 2011, at the court dancing practice for the Royal Ball. It was love at first sight, but since both were in college, and a long distance relationship was not an option, the two remained friends. They finally started dating in May of 2016, visiting each other frequently, and they agreed it was better on both of their wallets, to move in together at Jesse's house in Fort Collins. Martín has been playing in Unser Hafen and the Kingdom of the Outlands since 2008, and has won numerous awards including his Silver Tine, Keepers of the Portcullis, the Rose D'Or, and was inducted into the Order of the Golden Ring. Currently he is the Protector of Unser Hafen and is a cadet to Sir Don Michelangelo, who inducted him and Arianwyn into Cygnet House. Arianwyn found the SCA in 2010, when she attended her first Estrella War and was star struck. She played all over the Kingdom, including Tir Yisithyr, the

Barony of Atenveldt, Ered Sul, and Granite Mountian. She has her Court Barony, a Flower of the Desert, a Queen's Cypher, and a few Atenveldt baronial awards. Arianwyn quickly took to her new Barony of Unser Hafen, and at her first event in the Outlands, became Baroness Safiyya's Lady in Waiting. She has earned a Noble's Grace, as well as the Golden Columbine since she has moved from the sunny Kingdom of Atenveldt, and is the current Bard of Pencarth.



Martín is a late 15th century noble from the Castile-Navarra region of Spain, modernly known as the Basque and Cantabria regions. The inspiration for his persona is derived from his stay in the region when he studied abroad. His stay provided him an insiders look at the historical culture of Spain, and he quickly fell in love with the principles and community that was echoed in the area's past. Martín enjoys the sport of Rapier fighting, the chivalrous virtues of the society, the revelry of courtly dance, as well as providing service to his kingdom. Martín can be found out on the Rapier field, teaching his famous cape ability, as well as case, and many other techniques. He favors the Spanish style of fighting and is ambidextrous, being that he is left-handed with a pen. He hopes to gain knowledge for all things medieval, and has an extreme passion for history in general. Unser Hafen holds a special place in his heart, and he hopes to help the rapier community expand and succeed through his teachings and love of the sport. He wants to cultivate a stronger community across the Kingdom of the Outlands, and his goal for the Society is to make it a common household name.



Arianwyn is an early 15th century Welsh noble who loves to bake treats, cook feasts, host teas, courtly dance, and tailor various articles including embroidered purses. She is magically inclined and transforms into magical creatures around the firelight. Her most famous magic is her balancing technique, and has been spotted with not only a cup on her head but also baskets, gallon jugs, as well as books and more. She has aided in sewing for many crowns, hosted queen's teas, as well as provided plenty of service as a Lady in Waiting, and has been a deputy seneshal to the barony of Granite Mountain. She is an apprentice and student of Master Gunnar Skullspliter from Atenveldt, and has more recently been cultivating a happy apprenticeship to Countess Richenda de la Selva. In her society life she hopes to bring magic and inspiration to all that she meets. Her hopes for Unser Hafen include, a widening of younger populace who have the same passion for the Society as she does, and maybe some year wearing the fancy Baroness hat to help make those things happen. As for the Kingdom of the Outlands, Arianwyn wishes for more courtly dancing to take place, as well as a Society wide move for more medieval looking campsites.
