Greetings good populace!

This past month has been a whirlwind of activity. Investiture was a lovely event. THL Cecilia guaranteed us no snow, and there was plenty of sunshine and heat to go around. Lord Fálki Ásgeirsson is our new Defender. He took the field with a savage smile that never left his face, despite the heat.

The competition was fierce on the rapier field for the next Protector. We believe all of Unser Hafen's rapier fighters who were able vied for the privilege of being the next Protector for Unser Hafen. Alas, there could be only one winner, and it was Don Haggis. It was a joy to watch all the fighters from near and far take the field. A few were felled by the heat, and we are extremely grateful that many gentles listened to their bodies and stopped before their health was adversely affected.

We have just returned from Battlemoor X. Our Stone Wolves made a strong showing in numbers and recognition. We had the great pleasure of watching the spear tourney that Sir Felix ran. There were many amazing fighters and the competition was ruthless. We were also informed that THL Uchtred won the unbelted tournament. On the rapier side, Lord Murdoch hosted the first open invitation rapier torchlight tournament at Battlemoor. There were a whopping 25 fighters in the list. Furthermore, on the Cut and Thrust field, Unser Hafen had the largest contingent from our own Barony in the Torchlight Longsword Tournament. We fielded four fighters from our Barony, who stood with our Barony to fight! On the archery side, Unser Hafen was first on the field, started strong, and ran multiple events!

We watched the equestrians many times throughout Battlemoor. They escorted Their Royal Majesties on evening rides and into court. We greatly enjoyed the Rossfechten (fighting from horseback) tournament, which was a society first. Many of the participants were from Unser Hafen, and they represented the pack with honor and chivalry. We are so proud of the entire Outlands equestrian community for coming together to host the first Rossfechten tournament Society-wide. The winner of the tournament was THL Estefania de las Yeguas, and the prize was a gorgeous silk banner painted by our very own THL Lisette de Troyes.

There were many arts and science classes taught by members of our pack. The following gentles offered their time and expertise as teachers at Battlemoor X: Lady Carmina, Baroness Julia DiVerdi, Lady Ruth, Countess Richenda, THL Anne Elizabeth, THL Lisette, THL Perryn, Don Justin, and HO Safiyya. Plus many others who helped run the hafla, but whose names were not written down (we saw you!). It should be noted that Countess Richenda ran the first (annual) fishing tournament at Battlemoor with horsehair lines she spent the year making.

Close to our hearts is the Bannerette tourney at Battlemoor. It is a tournament that focuses on pageantry and teamwork. This year Unser Hafen fielded not one, but two full 7-man teams. Unser Hafen Emerald and Unser Hafen Topaz, representing the gems found in our hills, enriching the kingdom with their brilliance. We were able to offer hospitality and include two gentles who did not have teams to complete our own. One was Lady Cahan from Caerthe and the other was Lady Arabella from Artemisia. Our Stone Wolves represented the Barony with honor and grace, fighting like a well organized pack throughout the tournament.

On the brewing side, Lady Ruth of Birkenfeld and THL Soren Thorvaldsson won in the brewing competition at Battlemoor X. Lord William's creations, while not in the brewing competition, were highly sought after by Their Majesties, and rumor has it caused some conflict, as they each wanted their own cordials from him.

Overall, other groups took notice of Unser Hafen. Our Green and Gold pride was strong. Our processions into courts were envied, and the number that pitched in throughout the event caused the Royalty, Barons and Baronesses, Peers and many others to take notice of our populace, and share their kind words with us. We even had members from other Kingdoms coming up to us to thank us for the Hospitality Unser Hafen shared with them.

It is clear after attending Battlemoor X that our pack is strong, vibrant, supportive, and thriving. Please keep up the hard work and being the amazing Stone Wolves that each of you are. During Unser Hafen court, we were taken aback when we asked our members to stand if they had either won a tournament or volunteered at this Battlemoor. Nearly every member in the court stood! (Some local Exchequers are authorized to accept cash and issue receipts-- this is the only circumstance under which cash is acceptable. The local branch herald may not accept cash.)"

Tidbits and Translations

In The Wolf's Mouth

Miriam Volpe, Baroness of Unser Hafen

At Battlemoor X you may have heard me wish gentles, “In bocca al lupo!” as they took the field or entered a competition. The phrase is pronounced [in 'bokka al 'lu:po]. Aegeon's grandmother was a professional ballerina in Italy, and this phrase is how Italians wish each other good luck before a performance or daring activity. Aegeon grew up hearing it during his theater performances and passed it onto me after we grew to know each other. It is akin to the English idiom of “Break a leg.”

In bocca al lupo literally translates to “In the mouth of the wolf.” It is an acknowledgment of putting something/someone important into a dangerous or challenging situation. The traditional response is “Crepì il lupo!” or simply “Crepì!” Those responses are essentially saying, “I’m a kill it dead!”

We both found it very fitting to wish our pack members, In bocca al lupo, as we are the Stone Wolves. The next time you take the field remember that you may be putting your head in the wolf's mouth, but you're going to win because you are a fierce Stone Wolf supported by the pack that is Unser Hafen.
