

The More You Know

Creating Medieval Moments at Events

The Society of Creative Anachronism has a handbook of governing documents referred to as "Corpora". You can see these documents at https://www.sca.org/wp-content/uploads/2019/12/govdocs.pdf . It is full of all sorts of interesting things. One item is the definition of an event. According to Corpora:

"The term "Society event" refers to tournaments, feasts, and other activities whereby participants can display the results of their research into the culture and technology of the period in an environment which evokes the atmosphere of the pre-17th century Middle Ages and Renaissance." THE CORPORA OF THE SOCIETY FOR CREATIVE ANACHRONISM, INC. Page 13 April 1, 2022

The last section about environment is very important. The modern

world is stressful, and part of what we are seeking in the SCA is the feeling that we are stepping into another world, experiencing a "medieval moment" as it were. It is more fun to feel like we are in a candlelit hall of a castle than in a high school gym. It starts with the decorations set up by the event planners, but it is also up to each attendee. When you go to an event, ask yourself how you are adding (or detracting) to the ambience and enjoyment of others. There are a lot of things that you can do to make the event seem more medieval for yourself and the person next to you.

- Bring a goblet to drink out of instead of a water bottle or solo cup.
- Put your food on a nice serving dish (or something medieval-ish) if you are having a potluck (for example at Winter Oasis)
- Bring a tablecloth or a large piece of cloth. You can use it to cover up a plastic table, the ugly ping pong table in the corner, a modern cooler, or the golf bag you keep your rapier equipment in.
- Hide your bottles, cans, and plastic containers.
- Make a banner to hang.
- Bring a bunch of LED lights (soft yellow flickering preferably) so we can turn off the overhead lights.
- · Bring a medieval game to play.
- Upgrade your garb.
- Paint a tapestry to hang.
- Disguise your popup https://www.moirandalls.com/popup/index.htm
- Use a large piece of cloth or a cloak to hide your modern folding chair.
- · Make a flag.
- Use bamboo plates instead of paper plates if you want to use disposable feast gear.
- Make a backdrop to hide the mundane elements of the room.
- If you use a mundane item, hide it and be discreet about using it.
- Use things that "look" medieval-ish

We are all playing the game together. If we all work to play our best medieval game, we can create lasting memories for everyone. Baroness Richenda de la Selva
