## Estrella aka Floodstrella, Mudstrella, Swampstrella By Anne Elizabeth Morley

Estrella XXXV was both wonderful and miserable! During the War the location had not only the lowest high temperature on record, it had a 100 year storm causing snow throughout New Mexico and Arizona, including during our drive on I-10 within site of the Mexican mountains, and 2.5 inches of rain in the Phoenix area during a 48 hour period mid War. Our tent took in a little water while others in our camp had up to 2 inches in their tents after just 6 hours of rain. In still other areas the water was at least 6 inches deep. Many evacuated for a night or two, but many could not. The roads became deep, sucking mud, pulling off shoes and causing vehicles to get hopelessly stuck. After a couple days of glorious sunshine people parked in general parking waited 5 or more hours for their vehicles to be pulled out of the field. Schnepf Farm was wonderful, loaning wooden pallets to cross some of the particularly messy areas, spending days pulling vehicles out of the mud with their tractor and opening one of their barns for refugees.

With all of the down side, the camaraderie, generosity, care, concern and willingness to help within our Society was heartwarming. We looked after one another as a family should. Some fighting and some classes had to be canceled, but what took place was wonderful. The students in the class I taught put up with the cold breeze, chilling them and creating havoc with my demonstration flip-chart, yet they stayed for the two-hour class. In the class I attended that afternoon we moved away from a river flowing through the tent only to end up with more under our new location. None of that dampened spirits or disrupted learning. The fighting fields may have been soggy, but fighters fought, and a had a great final melee.

In the end, toilet paper ran out, port-a-potties filled up and trash piled up, including just about everything imaginable that could have been destroyed by the water. We shivered, talked and laughed around campfires, drummed and danced. We cemented old friendships and created new ones.


