Archery Report

Thank you to all the archers who attended and shot at Of Fire and Wind. We had a large turnout, which rivalled the number of rapier fencing participants. Also thank you to the autocrats and many helpers who set up the range beforehand, and to Master Dafydd of Emmett who helped out marshalling on Saturday, all of whom made life much easier for the Captain of Archers. On Saturday, we shot a Royal Round. Twenty-one archers participated, including at least one first-time youth archer, and many others new to Royal Rounds. This was also the first non-practice archery event that I marshalled. All scores have been submitted to the SCA archery scoring site, which will help new archers gain official ranking after a few more Royal Round shoots.

On Sunday, three archery events took place: Open target practice marshalled by Lady Vigdis Karrarbringa, an animal hunt, and a clout shoot. The animal hunt consisted of three rounds shooting at animal targets with the top three entering a 30 yard shoot-off. Conrad, Jamil, and Chaprick competed in the final round and Conrad prevailed. Finally, we shot a 100 yard clout shoot. Again, this was a first for many archers, and a great experience. After three rounds, Jamil took the win. Just after we had finished, the wind picked up, and we horridly packed up the equipment with the help of many.
