

Herald's Call

Awards

What do all the awards mean?

The best overview can be found by going to <u>outlandsheralds.org</u>. Choose the hyperlink for "Precedence & Awards" at the top. This will take you to the Wimble Herald website where you can search everyone who has ever received an award in the Outlands. Under 'Award Information' there are two links that hold a wealth of information. "Awards by Kingdom or Barony" will give you more details on what the award is and who can be considered for it. "All Awards and Orders for the Outlands and Baronies" lists all the awards as individual hyperlinks that help answer the next question.

Grant? Armigerous? What do these mean?

Armigerous awards are sort of the first level of awards a person can receive. These all carry an Award of Arms (AoA) where the person receiving it will simultaneously get their AoA if it has not yet been awarded. There are many Baronial awards that are armigerous and, depending on how the Crown wants to manage awarding AoA's, a Baron and Baroness may be asked to delay an award. Don't let this discourage you from submitting! I would even recommend you submit an AoA recommendation to Crown and the Baronial award in mind to Their Excellencies at the same time.

Grant of Arms are the next level up, where a person goes from 'Lord/Lady' to 'The Honorable Lord/Lady'. If a person has excelled in the arts but has not Arts & Sciences awards, it's best to submit them for the Armigerous level award (Argent Hart). If a person has excelled in the arts and you find they were awarded an Argent Hart some time ago, then go ahead and recommend them for the Grant level recognition for the arts (Flower).

After Grant level awards we have the Peerage Orders (Chivalry, Pelican, Laurel, and Masters of Defense). You do not have to be a Peer to submit a person for a Peerage. There is usually some more involved deliberation over offers of Peerage, but it never hurts to share good words of a person's efforts.
